

MINUTES of the Parish Council Meeting held in the Windmill Room, Wood Norton Village Hall on Monday 21st January 2013

The minutes were taken by R Condon, in the absence of the Clerk.

There were no members of the public.

Matters Arising

The Chair will contact Councillor Russell Wright to ascertain whether any progress has been made with regard to the number of caravans at 4 Acre Farm and whether there is any further information on the application for Wind Turbines at Brush Cottage Farm.

Finance

The revised paperwork for the precept was signed. North Norfolk Council now requires a different method of calculation, although the impact on the precept for parishioners will be the same.

Allotments

Di Dann on behalf of Stibbard Parish Council has reported that there may be a possibility of sharing Stibbard's Allotments. These are situated near the junction of the A1067 and the Stibbard Road. There are no amenities and the cost is £35 for a full plot and £18 for a half plot. The Chair is to visit and will contact anyone who expressed an interest.

Update on Wind Turbines

There have been no further developments reported.

Correspondence

- R. Hawking, a Hockering Parish Councillor, has written offering Wood Norton the benefit of their experience, if we decide to fight any proposed Wind Farm Developments. The clerk to respond, thanking R. Hawking, explaining there is no formal planning application currently, but contact details will be made available to any interested Wood Norton residents.

- NCC wrote advising there is a Public Enquiry for the Waste Facility at Kings Lynn starting from 26th February until 19th March. Details available from the Clerk.
- North Norfolk supplied a notice which will go on the Notice Board, giving details of an exhibition at Sea Palling, on 'Remembering the Floods of 1953'. Council representatives will also be there to advise on the importance of having a plan in the event of a community disaster.

It was felt that our community was small enough for a formal structure not to be necessary at the moment.

Any Other Business

- A report was tabled by PCSO Keith Clarke reporting 3 incidents, including 2 on the Holt Road, (damage to a bird scarer and a caravan that had been tampered with).
