

Minutes of the Planning Meeting of Wood Norton Parish Council held on Monday 27 November 2014 at Wood Norton Village Hall at 7.30pm.

Planning Application for continued use of former grazing land as garden and retention of polytunnel and greenhouse. Land rear of "Bellows", Blacksmiths Close, Wood Norton

Following a discussion and on the proposition of Cllr Bell seconded by Cllr Hunt, Wood Norton Parish Council objected to the application. All in favour.

Councillors commented that as this parcel of land has never had Planning Permission it surely cannot be 'continued use'. If this Planning Application is to be considered it must be change of use. Councillors would like this land kept as agricultural grazing. The Clerk will write to the District Council Planning department with the above comments.
