

MINUTES of the Parish Council Meeting held in the Windmill Room,
Wood Norton Village Hall on Monday 4 October 2010 at 7.30pm.

The meeting was opened for public participation and on being closed the minutes of the previous Parish Council meeting and a Planning meeting were approved and signed.

Matters Arising

Finance

The Precept for 2011-2012 was set at £2075. This was proposed by R. Hunt and seconded by M. Crowe. This was carried unanimously.

The Clerk has received a letter from North Norfolk District Council (NNDC) informing us that they are looking to recover the outstanding rental income. Audit Commission – the audit for 2009-2010 has been approved. A cheque for £58.75 for this work was proposed by J. Johnson and seconded by T. Lidstone-Scott. This was carried unanimously.
