

MINUTES of the Parish Council Meeting held in Wood Norton Village Hall on Monday 10 August 2009 at 7.30pm.

Mr T Lidstone-Scott chaired the meeting with Councillors: J. Johnson, I. Summons, P. Bell, R. Hunt and M. Crowe.
Apologies were received from J. Marchant, District Councillor Robin Combe and the PCSO (Police Community Support Officer) for this Parish Keith Clarke.

There were no members of the Public present.

The Minutes of the meeting held on 29 June 2009 were approved and signed.

Matters Arising

The Clerk has reported the pothole on Rectory Road to Highways at Norfolk County Council who have inspected it and will be carrying out remedial works. They have also inspected road deterioration on Church Lane.

The Clerk contacted Passenger Transport Group (PTG) at Norfolk County Council raising concerns that the 2 school buses meet on Rectory Road at the same time. A reply has been received from PTG but it was felt that they have misunderstood the Parish Council's concern. The Clerk will write again.

It was agreed to pursue the installation of posts on the corners of the Village Green to deter vehicles from overrunning.

The Clerk will contact Highways.

Planning

Agricultural Building at Mill Barn Farm, Holt Road has been granted.

Finance

Cost of remedial works for the Village sign – quote received from Mr D.Gedge for £126.26. This was agreed unanimously and the Chairman will instruct Mr Gedge to go ahead.

Home Watch

New signs have been installed on the Holt Road.

PCSO Keith Clarke has reported to the Clerk that a recent 'Speed Watch' on the Holt Road was very successful reminding drivers of the speed limit.
