

MINUTES of the Parish Council Meeting held in Wood Norton Village Hall on Monday 21 September 2009 at 7.30pm.

Mr T Lidstone-Scott chaired the meeting with Councillors: J. Johnson, I. Summons, R. Hunt and M. Crowe, District Councillor Robin Combe and the PCSO (Police Community Support Officer) for this Parish Keith Clarke.

Apologies were received from J. Marchant, Peter Bell.

There were no members of the Public present.

The Minutes of the meeting held on 10 August 2009 were approved and signed.

PSCO Clarke reported that there had been 4 recorded incidents within the Parish over the last 3 months. He also said that there will be more Speed Camera's active on the B1110 Holt Road.

Matters Arising

A member of the public has reported that using 'Google Maps' directs HGV's through the village rather than Rectory Road. Councillors were unclear of the relevance of this. Mr Lidstone-Scott will seek to clarify.

Village Sign update, Mr Gedge has almost completed remedial works although the costs may be slightly higher. It was agreed unanimously that this would be ok to a maximum of £150 and that a cheque should be raised as soon as the invoice was received rather than wait for the next Parish Council meeting.

The Clerk is contacting Highways regarding the posts (minutes of meeting 10 August 2009) on the village green.

The Annual Audit has still not been received from the Auditors.

Home Watch

The Home Watch signs ordered over two years ago have at last been received.

A Home Watch Coordinator for the main part of Wood Norton is now needed. Anyone interested please contact Mr Lidstone-Scott.

Proposed Faculty for re-building the Church Yard wall.

The Parochial Church Council is proposing to dismantle and rebuild a section of the Church Yard wall. Before applying for Faculty to undertake this work they are required to consult with the Parish Council. Mr Lidstone- Scott and Mrs Johnson both registered an interest. A vote was taken to agree to this work being carried out. This was agreed unanimously.
