Matters Arising

- There has been no update regarding the proposed Bernard Matthews wind turbine.

Planning Application

- Four Acre Farm, Holt Road, Conversion of stables/store to two units of holiday accommodation. Planning permission has been refused. The Clerk will contact the Enforcement Officer as there appears to be more caravans on site than is allowed also there is an issue of noise pollution at times.

Finance

- £131 was paid to J. Marchant for Jubilee expenses. Proposed M. Crowe and seconded T. Lidstone-Scott.
- Payments of £27.55 each have been received from the Village Hall and the Parochial Church Council for Jubilee expenses.
- Precept to be set at the next Parish Council meeting. The Clerk will forward the expenditure for a year to give guidance.
- The Clerk will contact Norfolk Association of Local Councils (NALC) for advice regarding the Surveyors Land as this is still shown as an asset on our annual audit returns.
